Local School Board Resolution No. 5, s. 2011

A RESOLUTION APPROPRIATING FUNDS FOR PRIORITY EDUCATION PROJECTS in the PROVINCE OF RIZAL

Be it enacted by the Local School Board of Rizal Province in Council assembled:

Section 1. Source of Funds - The following income as indicated hereof are hereby declared as sources of funds particularly, the additional one percent (1%) Tax on real property which are realistic and probable to be collected and be remitted to the Local Treasury, necessary to finance the implementation of priority education projects of the province of Rizal from January one to December thirty-one, two thousand and twelve, except otherwise specifically provided herein:
